A RECORD RUN?: Wes Timmons extended his on-base streak to an International League-best 44 games Wednesday...He is batting .349 (51-146) with 32 runs, 15 RBI, 36 walks and just 15 strikeouts during the streak. Although Triple-A records only go back to 2005, Timmons now owns the ninth-longest on-base streak on record...He is 11 games shy of the record, which belongs to **Andy Green**...Green had a 55-game on-base streak from June 12-Aug. 11 in 2005 while playing for the Tucson Sidewinders.

MONEY'S WORTH: Fans are getting their money's worth this season...The G-Braves average home game time is two hours and 52 minutes...With last night's win, Gwinnett is now 32-27 at home...On the road, the G-Braves have a better record at 34-24 but have averaged three fewer minutes per game at two hours and 49 minutes per contest, even with having to play the bottom of the ninth more often...On the road, Gwinnett has played in two doubleheaders, that at the Triple-A level are only seven innings long...Gwinnett has yet to play a doubleheader at home...The G-Braves have had four hours and 52 minutes of weather-related delay at Gwinnett Stadium compared to three hours and 25 minutes of delay on the road...The G-Braves are the only IL team to not lose an opening due to weather...In 117 games this season, Gwinnett has played 1,030.2 innings in 335 hours and 37 minutes or just shy of 14 days.

IT'S A WALK-OFF: **Brandon Jones** hit the first walk-off home run in Gwinnett Braves history on August 11, vaulting the G-Braves into first place in the International League South with a 5-4 win over the Durham Bulls...His game-winner came soon after **Reid Gorecki's** game-tying blast on the first pitch of the ninth inning...It was the second time that Gwinnett has used a multi-homer inning to win in comeback fashion at Gwinnett Stadium...The last time was on June 30 when Reid hit a grand-slam to tie the game and **Jordan Schafer** hit a solo-shot in the eighth to give the G-Braves an 8-7 win over Louisville. Jones has only recently found his power, which has been missing for much of the season...He didn't hit his first home run until July 12, his 66th game, but he has hit five bombs in 21 games since then.

RASMUS NO-HITTER FOR D-BRAVES: **Cory Rasmus** hasn't had an easy road, but the former first-rounder showed August 11 what he can do with the right breaks.

Making his third start of the season, Rasmus tossed a no-hitter and was one walk from perfection for the Rookie League Danville Braves.

"This team has a lot of good starters," said Rasmus. The 21-year-old right-hander struck out nine and took a perfect game into the fifth inning, where a leadoff walk to Ryan Wiegand proved to be his only blemish.

Danville has claim to the last two Appy League no-hitters. David Francis fanned 16 last season in a rain-shortened no-no against Pulaski on July 22.

"It's been a long, tough road so far," admitted Rasmus, who was selected by Atlanta with the 38th overall pick in the 2006 Draft.

The Georgia native's brother Colby is an outfielder with the St. Louis Cardinals.
